Subject: Clarification / Confirmation of CBSE Affiliation Byelaws – That Private School Can Be Run by a Registered Trust also.

Respected Sir/Madam,

I am writing on behalf of Alpha International School to give clarification regarding the eligibility of a registered trust to establish and run a private school in accordance with the CBSE Affiliation Byelaws. Our school received a deficiency saying "The School has uploaded Trust Deed instead of society registration certificate. Hence, school is required to upload society registration certificate with proper sign and seal of issuing authority as per appendix XVI of Circular No. 12/2022."

As per CBSE Affiliation Byelaws, Under Short Title and Commencement specifically clause no. 1.3.17, it is indicated that a private school can be operated /run by a registered trust. The clause denotes the permissibility of trusts in establishing and managing educational institutions under the purview of the CBSE guidelines.

Our institution, Alpha International School, is governed and managed by a registered trust as per CBSE Bye-Laws, adhering to all legal formalities and ethical standards. We firmly believe in the significance of providing quality education and contributing to the academic growth of students in line with the CBSE standards.

Hence our school does not need a society to run a school as our school is being run by a Trust.

3. The office of the Trust shall be at 2/310 Jeeva Street, Mondiamman Nagar, Red Hills, Madras-52, or such other places or places as may be decided by the trustees from to.

4. OBJECTS:

THE TRUST FUND SHALL CONSIST OF:

- a. The said sum of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) above referred to the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the TRUSTEES.
- b. Any money, properties moveables, immovables that be acquired by purchase, gift or donation or otherwise, all manner of right titles or interest over any properties, that may be acquires from time to time in the aforesaid manner.
- c. All additions and accretions to the TRUST property and
- d. All Voluntary donations, Gifts, corpus Donations, legacies or grants in cash or in kind accepted by the Trustee
- e. All the properties and income of the Trust shall be held solely for the objects of the Trust.

5. FOUNDER TRUSTEES:

The Trustees named in this deed of Trust namely Mr. Abraham George and Mrs. Jeeva

George shall be termed the Founder Trustees and shall constitute the Board. They shall hold their office for their lives. Mr. S. Abraham George shall be the first managing Trustee and chairman of the Board of Trustees. After the death of Mr. S. Abraham George (is) Managing Trustee Mrs. Jeave George will be the Managing Trustee.

6. CO-OPTED TRUSTEES: The Founder Trustees shall be two in number and shall function as the Board of Trustees. It shall be open to the Founder Trustees action as a Board to co-opt two or more additional Trustees. Such additional Trustees be termed as co-opted Trustees. Such co-opted Trustees shall hold office only for a period of 4 years from the date of such co-option after which period he/she shall vacate the office. The co-opted Trustee or Trustees shall be deemed to have vacated their office earlier on the following contingencies:-

a. If he/she does not desire to continue in office and resigns the office of the Trustees.

b. If he/she is adjudged insolvent.

c. If he/she suffers from any illness affecting his/her mental capacity.

d. If he/she suffers from any chronic illness physically preventing him/her from functioning as Trustee for a continuous period of six months.

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e. If by a majority decision of the Trustees the co-opted Trustee is expelled for reasons that such Trustee's action is prejudicial to the object and intent of the Trust.

7. SUBSTITUTED TRUSTEES: Whenever any vacancy is caused, by reasons of any founder Trustee vacating his or her office by reason whatsoever, the nominee of such Trustee if such nomination has been made, shall automatically be nominated to the Board in place of vacated Founder Trustee and such nominated person or persons shall hold the office of Trustee ship for his/her life unless he/she vacated the office of Trustee ship for any of the reasons contemplated as above. In the event of there being no nomination by such founder Trustee, the remaining founder Trustees shall have a right to jointly nominate a persons.

8. OTHER TRUSTEES:- Whenever a vacancy occurs by reasons of the co-opted Trustee vacating office under clause 6 above or by the substituted Trustee vacating this office under clause 7 above then in all such cases, the Board of Trustees may fill up such vacancy by co-opting a proper person to fill up the vacancy at a meeting, and the resolution being carried by a majority of the Trustees then present at the meeting. The office of any co-opted Trustee who vacates office by reason of expiry of the period of 3 years herein above shall be filled up by the founder

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9. CHAIRMAN:- Mr.S.Abraham George, one of the Founder Trustees of the Trust shall be the first chairman and shall also be the managing Trustee of the Board of Trustees and shall hold office as Chairman, managing Trustee until he declines to hold office or until by a majority resolution, the Board of Trustees decide to appoint any, other Trustee to the said office in which event the said Mr.S.Abraham George shall vacate office.

10. MEETINGS:- The Chairman of the Board of Trustees shall convene meetings of the Board whenever he considers necessary provided nevertheless, that at least one meeting of the board be endeavoured to be convened and held once in every three months.

11. QUORUM:- The quorum for the meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be 2 Trustees personally present at the meeting.

12. RESOLUTION:- At all the meetings of the Board, the Chairman shall preside, and in his absence, one of the Trustees present shall be elected to act as Chairman for the meeting. All resolutions passed at the meeting should be duly recorded in a book maintained for that purpose and duly signed by the Chairman of the meeting. Any resolution declared as passed in the said meeting shall be conclusive and binding on all the Trustees and shall be given full effect to. All questions relating to the administration of the Trust shall

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be decided by the majority of the Trustees either at the meeting of the Board the resolutions should be decided by show of hands, and in case of equality of votes, the chairman of the meeting shall have and exercise a second or casting vote.

13. SUB COMMITTEE: It shall be open to the Board of Trustees to constitute a sub-committee among themselves to attend to the day today administration of the Trust, and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees shall always be the ex-officio Chairman of all such committees. The committee so constituted shall have such powers as may be delegated to them by the Board of Trustees, and shall have the power to employ such staff, workers, etc, for carrying out the objects of the trust.

14. ADMINISTRATION:- The Board of Trustees shall have full power and authority to administer the Trust, its properties and affairs and to do all acts, deeds and things which are calculated to fulfil the objects of the Trust for which the Trust is created.

15. AND DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES:

a. The Trustees shall be entitled to use the Trust Fund and such moneys or properties as may become available from time to time for the purpose of carrying out the objects aforesaid.

b. The Trustees, if they find necessary shall be entitled to collect donations, legacies, grants etc, for the furtherance and advancement of the objects of the Trust either for corpus by way of endowment or otherwise for necessary expenses.

c. The Trustees may invest the Trust fund in such securities and business as they think fit, in the interest of Trust without contravening the provisions of the INCOME TAX ACT 1961.

d. The income from all Trust properties, investments and fund shall be devoted for the purposes of the Trust as may be decided by the Trustees from time to time and if necessary can be accumulated.

e. It shall be open to the Trustees to accept any donations for any special purpose earmarked by the donor or donors, and such donations shall be used for the purpose intended.

f. The Trustees shall have power to raise loans with or without securities for the purposes of the Trust, and to repay the same from out of the Income derived from the Trust properties, investments and funds or out of the donations specially earmarked for the purpose of repayment of debts.

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9. The Trustees shall keep and maintain accounts of all the Trust properties and the accounting year of the Trust shall be the year ending on 31st May every year.

The said account shall be audited every year by qualified Auditor, or Auditors Elected by the Trustees every year and the Audited Statements shall be signed by all the Trustees.

16. BANK ACCOUNTS: The Board of Trustees shall open one or more account or accounts in the name of the Trust with any scheduled Bank or Nationalised Bank and the said Bank account shall be operated by the Board of Trustees from time to time, either jointly or individually.

All amounts received to the account of the credit of the Trust shall be forthwith credited to the Banking Account of the Trust.

18. INDEMNITY:- Every Trustee, for the time being, shall be indemnified out of the Assets of the Trust Funds against any liability incurred by him in any proceedings. Either civil or Criminal in which the judgement is given in his favour or in which he is acquitted, provided the said proceedings

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relate to any matter arising out of the administration of any act lawfully and bonafied done by him as TRUSTEE:

19. UTILISATION OF TRUST FUNDS:- No part of the Trust, either the corpus or the income therefrom shall be utilised for any purpose other than that of the objects of the trust hereby created and shall be utilised in India for the benefit of the Public.

20. The Board of Trustees may by any supplementary instrument confer and provide for such power as may be required or found necessary for the proper administration of the TRUST.

21. Everything which may be done by the Founder Trustees above named from the date of this instrument of registration there of shall be binding on the Trust as having been done by them in the capacity of Trustees.

22. The founder Trustees or other Trustees in their relations shall not obtain any benefit whatsoever directly or indirectly from the income of the property of the TRUST.

23. CYPRESS: In the event of the failure of the Trust for want of its objects, or in the event of the Trust having become impossible of performance the Board of Trustees shall transfer all the net assets of all assets along with liabilities as may be found convenient to any other ex

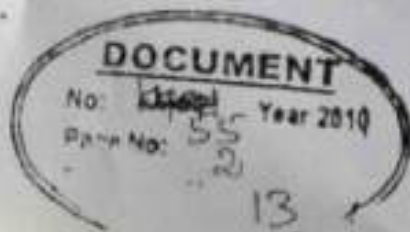

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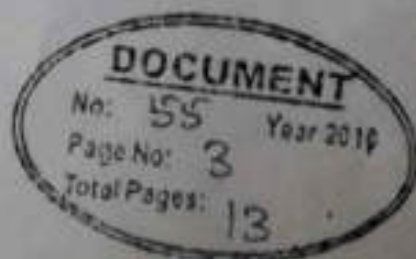

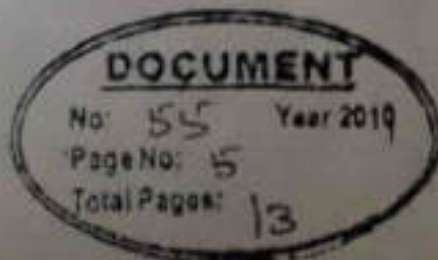

2. NAME OF THE TRUST

- h. To give subscriptions or donations to any charitable institutions;
- i. - j. To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise any property whether movable or immovable or any rights for the purpose of the trust;
- k. To sell, give or lease, mortgage or otherwise transfer any movable or immovable property or any rights thereon for the purpose of the trust;
- l. To construct, maintain or alter any buildings or works necessary for the purpose of the trust;
- m. To borrow money for the purpose of the trust upon any terms and conditions;
- n. To do all such other lawful things as may be considered incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects mentioned above;

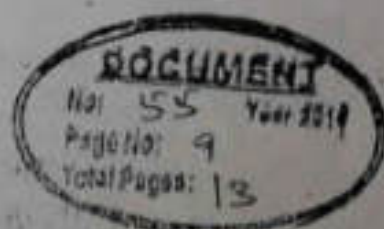

- iv) Vacancies caused in the office of the trustees shall be filled up by the remaining trustees by co-option only from the legal heirs of such outgoing trustee;
- v) In the event of any vacancy in the office of the Managing Trustee, the Vice Chairperson shall automatically become the Chairman and Managing Trustee;
- vi) The trustees shall be deemed to have vacated their office in the event of their (a) death or (b) resignation or (c) adjudication as insolvent or (d) becoming mentally / physically incapacitation or (e) removal from the trusteeship for their acts detrimental to the interest of the trust;

7. POWERS OF THE TRUSTEES

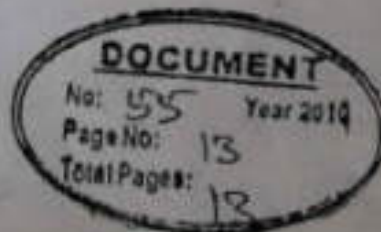

- d) The Secretary shall also assist the Chairman in the matters of receipts and payments, maintaining the accounts, arranging for audits and other regular activities;

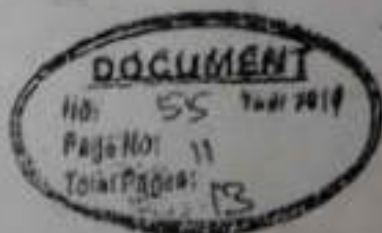
9. CUSTODY OF DOCUMENTS
