CONDITIONS:

1. The Applicant for the licensee shall have to make such alteration in the premises as may be required by the licensing authority
2. First Aid Box and sufficient number of fire extinguisher and fire buckets with water and sand should be kept ready to meet any contingences.
3. Necessary sanitation arrangements should be provided.
4. The Flooring Should be impervious and washable.
5. Drinking water with RO should be provided.
6. The Sufficient lighting and ventilation should be provided in and around the school Premises.
7. No objection Certificate should be obtained from the Divisional Fire Officer.
8. Minimum 15 feet distance should be maintained for the construction between bore wells and septic tank.
9. The number of Urinals/ Seats and toilet to be kept separately for boys, girls and staffs neat and tidy.
10. Strictly advise to follow the control measures of **Covid 19** Such as wearing face mask, Frequent Hand Washing, Temperature Screening, Surface Disinfection and Maintenance of Social Distance.
11. Mosquito Breeding sources should be avoided.
12. The waste should be removed from the school premises periodically.
13. No traffic obstruction of vechiles while dropping and picking up of students.
14. Play ground with all amenities should be provided.
15. Sanitary Certificate should be obtained for each and every Year

- That in all other necessary aspects, the sanitation is satisfactory subject to the following conditions.

CONDITIONS

1. All the Teachers and Students and Staffs should be examined by thermal scanning daily.
2. Toilet and urinals should be disinfected daily.
3. Drinking water sources should be Chlorinated daily.
4. Disinfection of Surface and Mopping of Floors should be done daily.
5. "No smoking" sign board, "No Plastic Zone" board should be displayed size of 3' x 1' in and around the building premises.
6. First Aid Box and sufficient number of fire extinguisher & fire Buckets water with sand should be provided.
7. The Fire Service licence should be obtained from Fire Service Department.
8. That the septic Tank Latrine with sufficient seats (Male & Female separately should be constructed with wire mesh over the ventilation pipe.
9. Strictly advise to follow the control measures of **Covid 19** Such as wearing face mask, Frequent Hand Washing, Temperature Screening, Surface Disinfection and Maintenance of Social Distance.
10. That the premises is free from mosquitoes, rodents and house flies nuisance.
11. TOFEI Certificate should be obtained from State TOBACCO Cell.
12. This Sanitary Certificate should be renewed once in a year.
